Background

This scholarship was established in memory of Doug Wills, a long-standing member of the Tuscarawas County Ag Society and a leader in our community. The scholarship will aid junior fair exhibitors in continuing their efforts to obtain a Certificate, Associate's degree, Bachelor's degree, or purchase materials to establish themselves in a trade. This is a one-time only scholarship.

Amount

Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1000 each.

Selection Procedure

The individual must:

- be an exhibitor at the 2024 Tuscarawas County Fair (this can be with an animal or still project taken by a 4-H or FFA member).
- be entering their freshman or sophomore year at the post-secondary institution of their choice or be entering the work force having attained a technical education certificate from an accredited institution.
- Have been an exhibitor at the Tuscarawas County Fair for the last 5 consecutive years.
- Award winners will be chosen by a sub-committee of the Tuscarawas County 4-H Committee.

Criteria

Selection will be based on:

- Junior Fair experience,
- other activities, i.e., school, clubs, church, and community, and
- interview (as determined by the Scholarship Committee).

Required Recommendation Letters

- 1 Advisor (4-H or FFA).
- 1 from other (club, group, school, etc.).

Essay

Describe how your participation in the Tuscarawas County Fair has prepared you for your future. The essay must be more than 200 words but under 350 words and typed or printed clearly.

If selected, you must present a copy of your post-secondary institution invoice, first semester transcript, grade report, or other documentation from your college/university to receive the scholarship award. If entering the work force and using this scholarship to purchase tools/supplies, you must provide a list of items to be purchased and submit a copy of the receipt after purchase.
